**Questions for this week:**

1. What drew you to come to Ocean Hills? If you had to describe Ocean Hills in one sentence, what would you say? What makes Ocean Hills distinctive?
2. What do you think is the #1 reason people don't go to church? Would you feel comfortable bringing a non churched person to Ocean Hills? Why/Why not?
3. Read Matthew 9:9-13. What stands out to you from this passage? Why?
4. How does Jesus model what the church should be in this passage? Do you feel like most churches are like this? Why/Why not?
5. What are some of the challenges for a church to welcome people “just as they are”? Do you think it's okay to “belong before you believe?”
6. Do you think a church should keep welcoming people “just as they are” even if they never change? Is the church responsible for changing people-- or is that in God's hands? What should the church's role be?
7. Jon talked about what the church “smells like”. If you had to describe the smell of our church, what would it be? Is it a good smell, or a bad smell? Does it draw or repel?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 2:14-15. What does Paul say in this passage about how the church should smell? Why do you think Paul uses the sense of smell to describe our influence?
9. If you had one wish for Ocean Hills, what would it be? What would it take for us to make that happen?
